Tournament Rules

- ◆ All age groups will play two 16 minute halves stop and go time
- ◆ 4 time outs per game, 3-5 minute half time (per ref. discretion)
- ◆ 3 minute overtime, 2nd OT will be 2 minutes, 3rd OT sudden death (first to score)
- ◆ 1 time out in overtime

CT High School Rules: No 1 and 1 on the seventh foul. Shoot 1 and 1 on the tenth foul. No 2 shot bonus. Players must wait for ball to hit rim and any # of lane spaces can be occupied

- ◆ Coaches can call timeouts
- ◆ Certified referees

Tournament Notes

- ◆ Players will need to bring with them two sets of different colored uniforms (Home Team wears white)
- ◆ Please bring your own basketballs. No basketballs will be provided
- ◆ We will have a scoreboard available for your game. Each team needs to provide a scorekeeper
- ◆ First team listed on the schedule will be the home team
